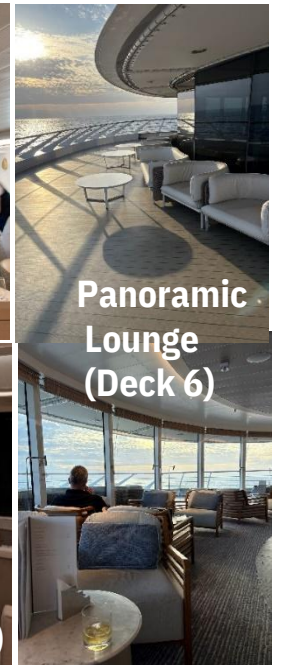
Onboard Facilities

At night, the lights around the windows turn on, making it a popular, moody lounge where you can watch the fish passing by.

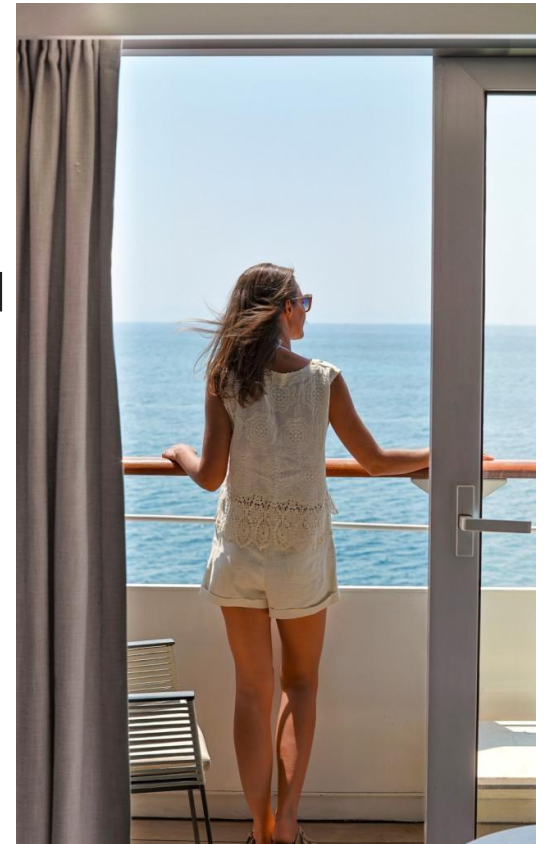

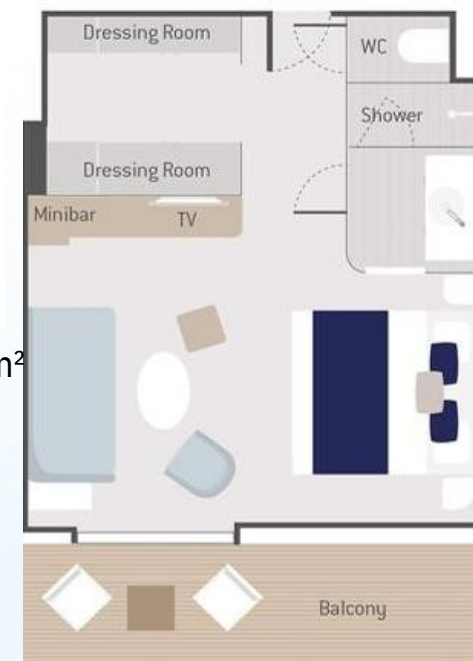

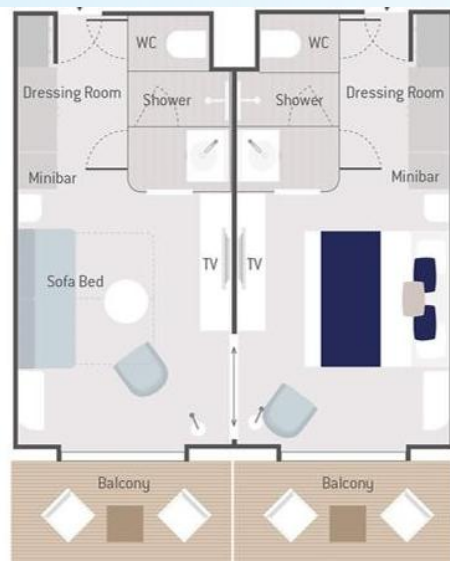

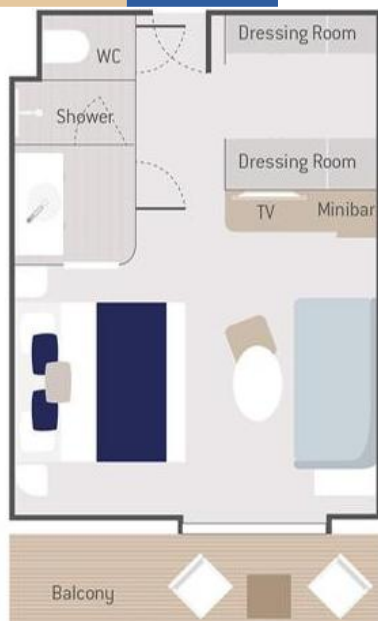

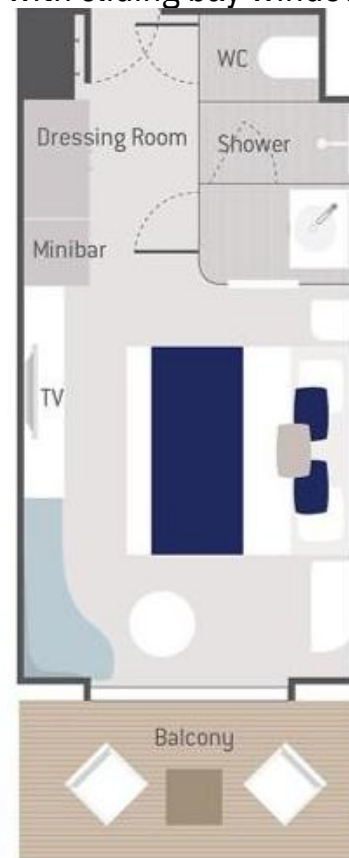

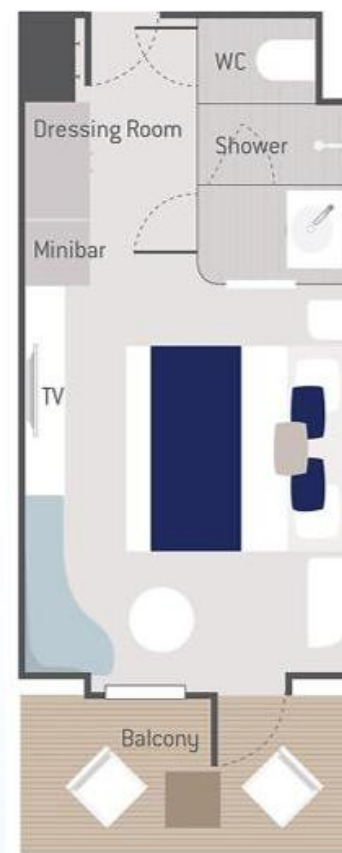
